In March of 2019, the State of Florida through legislation under HB 1073, established the Florida Open Financial Statement System which calls for local governments to report financial information using the eXtensible Business Reporting Language (XBRL). This webinar covers topics related data standards and financial reporting. The objective of this session is to educate government financial officers on what tools are available, why data standards are beneficial, and the impact of standards on their internal data preparation processes.
