Overview:

In response to questions that we have received regarding this topic, the FGFOA Education & Webinar Committee has added this topic to our regular FGFOA Webinar Series schedule.

Robert Larkin will present a webinar on the application of the Families First Coronavirus Act ("FFCRA"), which has amended the Family and Medical Leave Act ("FMLA") and is now applicable to all Public Entities in the State of Florida. The Webinar will also discuss the application of Governor DeSantis' Executive Orders (EO 20-83 and 20-91) concerning COVID-19 and the Federal Department of Labor's Rules interpreting the FFCRA.

The FFCRA webinar will provide guidance to public employers on handling Emergency Paid Sick Leave related to COVID-19 as well as additional paid FMLA leave that may be available to employees. In addition, the webinar will discuss the designations of "health care provider" and "Emergency Responder" as well as assisting public employers in determining which employees may be designated as "essential" during this COVID-19 crisis. The webinar will be followed by a question and answer session.
