The Accounting Manager works under executive direction. The purpose of the job is to supervise and perform highly complex and advanced accounting work according to generally accepted standard accounting principles, established procedures, departmental guidelines, and regulatory requirements applicable to the work. Employees in this job classification function manage assigned finance systems and operations according to established schedules, calendars, projects, and programs of the assigned department.

The Accounting Manager must have strong supervisory skills required to supervise staff comprised of accountant, entry and journey level employees engaged in carrying out complex accounting support functions. thorough knowledge of pre-established local, state, and federal policies, procedures and regulatory requirements applicable to the work, thorough knowledge of generally accepted standard accounting principles, established procedures, departmental guidelines, and regulatory requirements applicable to the work and current knowledge of industry, regulatory and legislative developments affecting accounting and financial reporting functions to ensure application to areas of responsibility.

Minimum Qualifications: Graduate of a four year, accredited, college/university with a Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Finance, or related field. Five years of experience in governmental accounting and accounting-related business. One year of supervisory experience. Must possess and maintain a valid Florida Driver's License. Preferred: Supervisory experience in a governmental environment, Florida CPA license, CGFO certification desired.
