MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Experience:

Bachelor's degree in accounting, finance or related field; supplemented by five or more years' progressively responsible experience in professional accounting, preferably in a governmental environment, and one or more years' experience leading the work of others; or an equivalent combination of education, certification, training and/or experience. Must have National Incident Management System (NIMS) certification (IS 700, 800, 100 and 200), or obtain within one year of employment. Certified Public Accountant (CPA), Certified Government Finance Officer (CGFO), or Certified Professional Finance Officer (CPRO) preferred.

In addition to meeting the minimum qualifications listed above, an individual must be able to perform each of the established essential functions in order to perform this job successfully.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:
