Manages the resilience strategy overseeing the preparation and implementation of effective high-priority resilience initiatives to address urban, regional, sustainability, transportation and economic resiliency challenges faced by the City and its residents. Ensures that the resilience strategy has a clearly defined direction, with specific outcomes and metrics. Provides policy and planning advice on resilience concepts and priorities in response to emerging trends and impacts.
