Minimum Qualifications: Associate's degree or two (2) years full-time professional experience in criminology, parole/probation work, psychology, or social work requiring case management and/or resident evaluation of inmates; or any equivalent combination of related training and experience. Must possess a current State of Florida Correctional Officer certificate and meet any other State of Florida Correctional Officer requirements under Florida Law. Successful completion of a pre-employment physical examination is required prior to employment. Must satisfactorily complete local, state and national criminal history and fingerprint checks. Correctional Officer Certification must be maintained as a condition of employment; re-certification required every four years. Must successfully obtain the FDLE Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) Certification within 6 months of employment or upon assignment which requires access to the Florida Crime Information Center (FCIC) National Crime Information Center (NCIC). Certification must be maintained as a condition of employment; re-certification required every two years. This is Level One certification.

NOTE: This position is assigned to the County Work Release Facility housing female inmates. In accordance with the Florida Model Jail Standards, Section 4.05, this position must be filled by a female. Therefore, only female applicants meeting the posted minimum requirements will be considered for this position.
