Additionally, it explores the role of artificial intelligence in enhancing payment processes and security and introduces solutions like Entity Validation Services (EVS) and Account Validation Services (AVS) to verify identities and account information, thereby reducing the likelihood of fraudulent activities and erroneous payments.
