



## ARPA Alert - Reporting Deadline for All Cities is this Saturday, April 30

### \*\*\*IMPORTANT REPORTING DEADLINE THIS WEEK FOR ARPA RECIPIENTS\*\*\*

Every city that received funds from the American Rescue Plan Act State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) is required to submit a **Project and Expenditure Report to the U.S. Department of the Treasury by this Saturday, April 30**. **Please make sure that your report is submitted by this Saturday.**

**Important:** Per Treasury, the most flexible and streamlined option for using SLFRF funds is the **Standard Allowance**. Cities can use up to \$10 million (including their full allocation if under \$10 million) for “government services.” If cities plan to select this option, **this one-time decision must be reflected in this report**. Treasury is recommending that NEU cities with allocations under \$10 million select the Standard Allowance.
