The Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) is conducting a survey of preparers of governmental financial statements regarding the reporting of *nonfinancial assets*. The survey is part of a GASB research effort that, in part, will evaluate the need for specific guidance related to the nonfinancial asset classification.
