



New Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Interim Final Rule

TREASURY RELEASES SLFRF INTERIM RULE

The U.S. Department of Treasury has released updates to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, or SLFRF, authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

In August 2023, Treasury released the 2023 Interim Final Rule that implements new uses authorized in the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023. The new eligible uses allow recipients to use program funds for emergency relief from natural disasters, community development, and surface transportation projects. The existing eligible uses are generally unchanged, and recipients may continue to use SLFRF funds in accordance with the 2022 final rule. Recipients will have the opportunity to submit comments on the 2023 Interim Final Rule through the [Federal eRulemaking Portal](#).

Key items for recipients to note:
